- 4) Because many authors may make significant contributions to collaborative research such as conducting experiments and analyzing data.
- 5) They have developed their own authorship policies or adopted widely recognized international guidelines.
- 6) The number of authors per paper is constantly rising.
- 7) The authors found a significant difference in the number of authors in empirical and conceptual papers.
- 8) Authorship guidelines can help to support two key ethical values.
